Projects and Achievements (2024-25)

Project – 1

Sewing Machine Operator Training (Batch 1)

Start Date: 11 March 2024

Completion Date: 11 May 2024

Location: NEWS Society, Lalchandpura, Jaipur

Supported by: Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI)

Impact:

- Trained 35 women, many of whom were unemployed or from economically weaker sections.
- 27 graduates secured employment in local tailoring and garment units.
- 5 participants started their own small businesses, earning between ₹8,000-₹12,000 per month.



Projects and Achievements (2024-25)

Project – 2

Sewing Machine Operator Training (Batch 2)

Start Date: 6 November 2024

Completion Date: 18 January 2025

Location: NEWS Society, Lalchandpura, Jaipur

Supported by: Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI)

Impact:

- Aimed at training another 40 women, with a focus on practical skills and market linkages.
- Includes sessions on financial literacy and business management to encourage entrepreneurship.
- Post-training, the participants will be connected to garment industries and self-help groups for sustainable income generation.



Projects and Achievements (2024-25)

Project – 3

Natural & Block Printing Training

Start Date: 6 October 2024

Completion Date: 16 December 2024

Location: Village Devaliya, Bagru

Supported by: Mahindra World City, Jaipur

Impact:

- Trained 25 rural artisans in traditional block printing techniques.
- Encouraged the use of eco-friendly dyes and sustainable practices, preserving cultural heritage while creating new market opportunities.
- Facilitated collaboration with local textile businesses, providing participants with real-world exposure and job opportunities

Project – 4

Setup of Library and Training Centre

Start Date: 9 January 2025

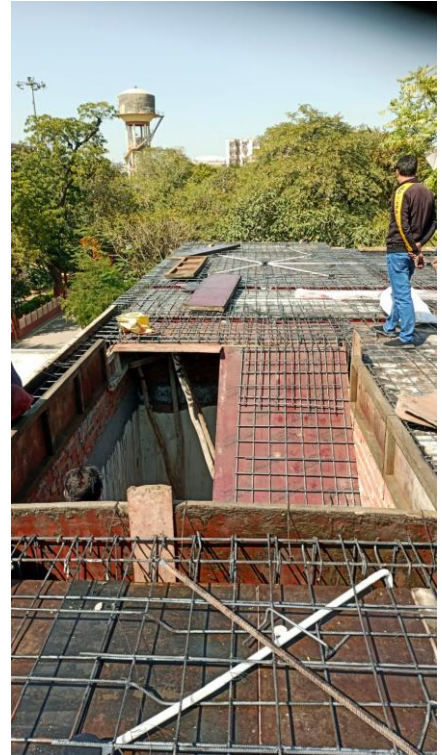
Completion Date: 31 March 2025 (Tentative)

Location: Police Line, Chandpole, Jaipur

Supported by: Mahindra World City, Jaipur

Impact:

- Aims to provide free access to books, digital learning resources, and skill development courses.
- Expected to benefit over 500 students and community members annually.
- Will serve as a multi-purpose hub for vocational training, workshops, and career guidance programs.





Overall Impact of NEWS Initiatives

- 100+ individuals trained in sewing and block printing.
- 70%+ placement rate for sewing machine operator trainees.
- 5+ new women-led enterprises established.
- Increased income generation for families in rural and urban Jaipur.
- Promoted sustainable and eco-friendly skills through block printing training.
- Strengthened educational access through the upcoming library and training centre.



Future Plans (2025-26)

1. Expanding Vocational Training Programs

- Launching Advanced Tailoring & Embroidery Training to enhance skills beyond basic sewing.
- Introducing Digital Marketing & E-Commerce Training to help artisans and small businesses sell their products online.

2. Strengthening Market Linkages

- Partnering with local businesses and online marketplaces to provide direct sales channels for trainees.
- Organizing exhibitions and craft fairs to showcase and sell handmade products from our training programs.

3. Scaling the Library & Training Centre

- Expanding the centre's resources to include computer training and career counseling sessions.
- Setting up mobile learning units to reach more underserved communities.

4. Empowering More Women & Youth

- Increasing outreach to rural and marginalized communities, ensuring inclusivity.
- Strengthening self-help groups and micro-financing support for women entrepreneurs.
